

Need a summer job? Opportunity in Recreation

Work part- to full-time in Lava Hot Springs!

Job Description: A lifeguard's job is prevention. Lifeguards are able to caution swimmers and divers regarding unsafe practices. A lifeguard is watchful, patient, and mature, and s/he can enforce pool rules in a polite, assertive manner. In addition, s/he will rescue swimmers in danger of drowning and follow established EAP procedures in the event of an emergency. Lifeguards are responsible for keeping emergency equipment (rescue tubes, backboard, signs, and other equipment) available and in good condition. Lifeguards are able to accurately complete incident reports. S/he will have secondary duties including helping to keep facility clean and performing pool opening and closing duties. Lifeguards will also help in the office as needed. Lifeguards will operate slides and may assist with ground keeping duties if interested. The positions are available from mid-May through Labor Day, and shifts are approximately 11am until 8pm. This is an excellent opportunity to learn and utilize emergency response skills.

Requirements: Applicants demonstrate comfort in the deep water and are able to swim 300 yards continuously using front crawl and breaststroke. Applicants can retrieve a 10 pound brick from deep water and exit the pool at the edge without using a ladder or stairs. Candidates are to tread water keeping the head above water for two minutes. Candidates will be at least 15 years old and hold certificates in first aid, CPR, AED use, and lifeguarding. Lifeguards will be able to work some Sundays and holidays when needed.

Get Certified: American Red Cross Lifeguarding Classes to be held in Lava Hot Springs for as little as \$50. For more information about becoming a certified lifeguard and to view upcoming class dates, please visit the link listed below.

Compensation: \$8.40/hour with the opportunity to work up to 40 hours/week. As a Lava Hot Springs Foundation employee, a lifeguard is given free entry to the Olympic Swimming Complex and the World Famous Hot Pools for his or herself, spouse, and dependent children.
